Please could the infant children bring in a black and white photo for art on Monday. This should be of a person, if possible.

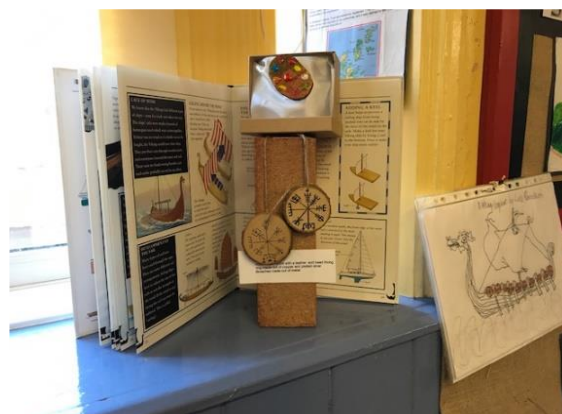
### IDL
