## School signs

Thanks to all who entered our competition to name the two school buildings. It was obvious that a lot of research had gone into this as there were a number of suggestions relating to past history of the village. The children had the final vote and the names chosen were North & South!! The main building is North and the building with the conservatory is South. This may take a little getting used to as the buildings have just been juniors and infants since time began!!

## Morning drop off

On a morning, Reception children and years 1, 2 & 3 should be dropped off at South building NO EARLIER THAN 8.50am. Breakfast club is no longer held in that building so staff are not on duty until 8.50am. If your child needs to be at school earlier, then they should be taken to breakfast club at North building.

Years 4, 5 & 6 should be dropped at North building NO EARLIER THAN 8.50am.
